

COMPETENCES, EXPERTISE AND KNOW-HOW

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) requests Companies to meet its standards on all processing activities of personal data, including for example: location data, IP addresses and Internet of Things data - these are *personal* data.

Under the GDPR, organisations are subject to high fines, so dealing with non-compliance must be a serious overall attitude, now more important than ever.

The best way to handle GDPR is find competences on data protection, hard to build due to their cross-disciplinary aspects: GDPR is not only a matter of law neither engineering, and it needs to be applied concretely (not formally) on Your business.

WHO NEED TO RESPECT GDPR?

GDPR applies to *all* Organizations which act as controllers or processors and process personal data for commercial purposes. Any processing of personal data in the context of the activities of an establishment of a controller or a processor in the Union should be carried out in accordance with GDPR, regardless of whether the processing itself takes place within the Union.

WHAT ARE NON-COMPLIANCE CONSEQUENCES?

Infringements of the GDPR requirements can subject Organization to administrative fines up to 20 ml EUR or 4 % of the worldwide annual turnover.

WHAT TO DO?

Every Organization that is approaching GDPR should understand in what extent the Regulation is applicable to its business, through a proper GDPR assessment: this is the very first step to respect the principle of accountability.

Every Organization will then be able to act on specific requirements and measures which will be identified taking into account the state of the art of the business, the costs of implementation and the nature, scope, context and purposes of processing as well as risks of on rights and freedoms of data subjects.

Now. The GDPR rules are applicable since 2018!
